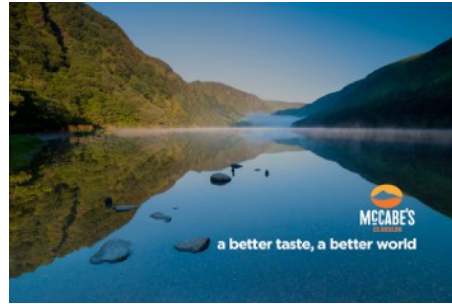


We hope you enjoyed the Christmas break and are ready for a busy year ahead. We've been busy at the roastery. Check out what we've been up to below

Our new blend -Pura Vida is now available. Juanitos in Drury St launched this delicious new blend when they opened a few weeks ago. 'Pura Vida' is a phrase in Costa Rica we heard so many times when we visited farms here a few years ago. It means staying happy, optimistic and full of life. We have developed a great relationship with Diego Robela who manages Aquiares estate in Turrialba. The blend is 100% Arabica, made up of mainly Aquiares estate Costa Rican coffee and a little Brazil, Sumatran and Indian to produce a deliciously rich espresso with notes of melon, hazelnut and milk chocolate.



## New Compostable leaf tea pouches

Our new branded leaf tea pouches will go live shortly. These are made in Ireland and are 100% compostable. Following extensive research of recyclable bags we discovered that these are all exported to Asia and are very difficult to recycle despite 3 of our competitors now using them. We have been advised that they are likely to be incinerated or dumped in these countries. The compostable bags we have chosen, if disposed of in brown bins, will be converted into high quality compost for Irish farmers! We plan to switch the coffee pouches to compostable once existing stocks run out.
